MATHS

LAST WEEK: We started Place Value; comparing and ordering numbers up to 1,000 and recognising the different place value columns for 3 digit numbers.

- I can mentally add and subtract numbers with up to 3 digits.

ENGLISH

- I can recognise the features of a warning story and I can write my own.
