Our Core Subject Learning Focuses

LAST WEEK: Our learning focus is on decimals. We will be looking at the relationship between tenths as fractions and decimals. We will learn the roles decimals play in place value and how to round to the nearest whole number. We will also be learning to order numbers that use decimals.

THIS WEEK: We will be doing Assessments of the children for Autumn. After starting the term so well, we will be expecting the children to have made progress from the tests we did at the beginning of the year. There will be three tests in Maths this week.

ENGLISH

LAST WEEK: We will begin the process of innovating the story of 'Zelda Claw and the Rain Cat.' We will look at the features and techniques used by Pie Corbett and understand the impact they have on the reader. We will box the story up to see its structure and continue to learn the story so we can retell it without prompts.
