

Our Core Subject Learning Focuses

MATHS

LAST WEEK: We looked at written methods for addition and subtraction.

Our targets were:

- I can recognise the place value of each digit in a 3/4 digit number.
- I can add and subtract up to 4 digit numbers using the column method.

THIS WEEK: We will be looking at mental methods for addition and subtraction and using them in word problems.

Our targets are:

- I can count on in ones, tens and hundreds from any 3 digit number.
- I can count back in ones, tens and hundreds from any 3 digit number.
- I can recognise the vocabulary for addition and subtraction in word problems.

ENGLISH

LAST WEEK: We were introduced to Traditional Tales and wrote our 'cold task.'

Our targets were:

- To understand a traditional tale.
- I can write a traditional tale.

THIS WEEK: We will be learning the story of 'The Mystery of The Hare and the Moon' by Pie Corbett. We will also be learning to use adverbs to show when, where or how an action happened. We will get our new targets as a result of feedback from our 'cold tasks.'
