Our Core Subject Learning Focuses

LAST WEEK: We are continued to look at reflection and symmetry in 2D shapes at the start of the week. In the later stages of the week, we learnt about multiplication methods, with particular focus on the 6x table and 9x table.

THIS WEEK: We are focusing on equivalent fractions and noticing the relationships between fractions. We will be learning how to show equivalent fractions through diagrams and pictures. Later in the week, the children will be exploring fractions of numbers. Our targets for this week are:

- I know what a fraction is.
- I know the vocabulary of fractions (denominator and numerator).
- I can find equivalent fractions and prove them in diagrams.
- I can find fractions of a number.

ENGLISH

LAST WEEK: We were learning to imitate 'The Mystery of The Hare and The Moon' traditional tale. Using our understanding of the structure and language of the tale, we have recreated the tale with our own ideas.
