Mr Belgrave's Sporting News!

On Wednesday 19th September the girls' football team played their first league game of the season against High-field. The game started with both teams having early chances, but it was Pickhurst who raced into a 3-0 advantage at half time. The 2nd half began with Pickhurst playing some nice passing football forcing a number of corners and creating numerous chances. The team added a further 4 goals to see the final score finish 7-0. This was a great start of the season by the girls. Well done.

On Wednesday 26th September the Tri Golf team travelled to Chelsfield Lakes Golf Club to take part in the Bromley Schools Competition. The team took part in a variety of golf related activities and they thoroughly enjoyed the experience. They were very unlucky not to win the competition, only losing out by 20 points which meant Pickhurst finished runners up. I was so proud of the team, not only for the way they performed but also for how well they worked as a team.

On Friday 28th September the girls' football team played in the Bromley Schools 7 a side Competition. The girls played 5 games, winning 2, drawing 1 and losing 1. Unfortunately, this meant that Pickhurst just missed out on qualifying for the semi finals. It was a good effort by the girls.

On Tuesday 2nd October the mixed netball team travelled to Newstead Wood School to take part in the Bromley Schools netball qualifiers. We took 2 teams to the competition and both teams played exceedingly well. One of the Pickhurst teams came first and the other team came second. This meant Pickhurst will have a team in the finals trying to qualify for the London Youth Games; a great effort by all.

On Wednesday 3rd October, the boys' 7 a side team travelled to St Mary's to try to qualify for the Bromley Schools Final. The first game was against St Mary's and although dominating the game, Pickhurst failed to take their chances and lost the game 1-0. The second game was against Wickham Common; again, Pickhurst dominated but failed to score and the game finished 0-0. This meant Pickhurst would have to win their remaining 3 games to have any chance of qualifying. I am so proud to say the boys won their remaining 3 games against Clare House, Warren Road and Crofton, which meant they qualify in first place for the finals at Orpington Rovers.

On Friday 5th October, the girls' football team played Balgowan in the first round of the Bromley Schools Cup. The girls dominated the game from start to finish and ran out comfortable winners by 7 goals to nil. It was a great team effort with some clinical finishing by the attacking players and a great defensive performance by the defenders and the goal keeper.

On Tuesday 9th October, Mr Winkless took the boys' football team to play Parish in a league game on a pitch that was a little on the small side with very small goals; the team produced a very professional performance, despite the difficult circumstances and won the game by 2 goals to 1.

On Wednesday 10th October, the boys' football team played their second league game against St Mark's. The team played some good attacking football, creating a number of chances before half time to lead by 3 goals to nil. The team dominated the second half and added 4 further goals to the score line to win the game by 7 goals to nil. A good team performance boys - well done.

On Friday 12th October, the boys' 7 a side team travelled to Orpington Rovers to take part in the Bromley School Finals. Pickhurst were one of 6 schools to make the final with everyone playing each other on the day. Pickhurst played their first game against Red Hill and although I felt we were the better team, the score line of a 3-0 defeat did not reflect the game. The second game was against Hayes, the boys produced an excellent performance and won the game 1-0. Our third game was against Southborough and the boys played some free flowing football, creating numerous chances and won the game by 3 goals to nil. Our fourth game was against St Mary's and, although dominating the game, Pickhurst failed to take any of their chances and the game finished goal-less. This meant our final game against Highfield became a Cup Final, meaning, whichever team won the game, would become Bromley Champions. Pickhurst started the game very fast and took a 2-0 lead by half time. The second half Highfield came back into the game and scored with 2 minutes to go to set up a grandstand finish, but Pickhurst defended resolutely and won the game by 2 goals to 1. This meant that Pickhurst became Bromley Champions, winning the first bit of silverware of the season and the team will now go on to represent Bromley at the Kent Finals on Saturday 10th November at Thamesmead. It was a great team performance and the team thoroughly deserve the opportunity to try and become Kent Schools Champions.

On Tuesday 16th October, the swimming team took part in the Bromley Schools Swimming Gala at Beckenham Spa. The whole team were a credit to the school, performing in their individual and team events. Pickhurst narrowly missed out on becoming large school champions and finished the competition in the silver medal position. I was so proud of how all the children swam - well done.

On Wednesday 17th October, the girls' football team took part in the Crystal Palace 6 a side competition and although the girls were unbeaten on the day, winning 4 and drawing 2 games, they finished the competition 1 point behind the winners to finish in the runner up position. The girls were excellent on the day and I was very proud of how the whole team performed.
