Curriculum Provision

In the event remote learning is required for an individual pupil.



Pupils will be set work via weekly newsletters with dedicated activities, resources and online links for home learning via their Google Classrooms. Work packs will be provided for pupils who do not have access to suitable IT provision.



Teachers will respond to emails for support and feedback via the class emails. However, it must be noted that the teachers will be teaching their class in school during the day and access to emails will be limited.

Pupils will be set work via the weekly newsletter with dedicated activities, resources and online links for home learning via their Google Classrooms, which are integrated into the school curriculum. Work packs will be provided for pupils who do not have access to IT provision. Children will need to upload work onto their Google Classroom account as required by the class teacher. This will be reviewed and monitored by the class teacher.



Teachers will be available to provide feedback via Google Classroom.



Engagement with home learning is mandatory. Engagement and progress will be tracked by pupils' class teachers and the Senior Leadership Team. In order to support this:

SCHOOL WILL:

Provide remote learning that is accessible to all; providing quality learning opportunities and feedback from teaching staff on progress.
Provide learning packs in a hard copy for those families who cannot access Wi-Fi or suitable technological devices to access the learning set.

FAMILY WILL:

Support their child/ren with remote learning during any periods of class/school closure or self-isolation.
Ensure all remote learning is undertaken as per the school's recommendation.
Ensure that they communicate with the school any reason why the remote learning may have not taken place.
Notify the school if they do not have access to technological devices or Wi-Fi in order to access the remote learning.

CHILD WILL:

Complete all remote learning set by the teacher during any periods of self-isolation of class/school closure.
Try their very best with all aspects of remote learning.

IN-SCHOOL PROVISION FOR WHOLE SCHOOL CLOSURE

In the case of whole school closures due to a pandemic, we will only be able to offer limited in-school provision to ensure the safety of staff and pupils as well as reduce transmission of infection.

Priority will be given to:

1. Vulnerable children
2. Children with an EHCP
3. Pupils where parents are critical workers

The school has the right to apply the prioritisation criteria on a case by case basis.
