## Key Vocabulary

**Continent** - any of the world's main continuous expanses of land (Europe, Asia, Africa, North and South America, Australia, Antarctica).

**Region** - an area, especially part of a country or the world having definable characteristics but not always fixed boundaries.

**Borough** - a town, or district within a large town, which has its own council.

**Regeneration** - reversing economic, social and physical decline in areas with support from the government.

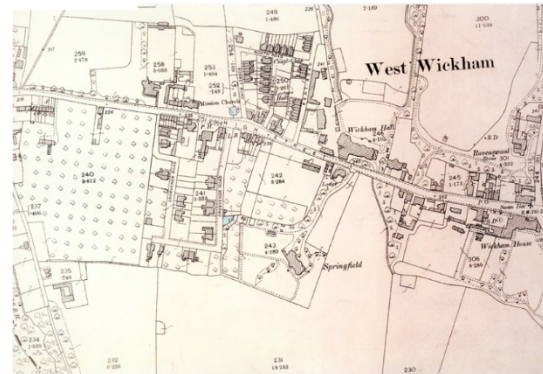
**Sustainability** - humans' interaction with the environment in a way that ensures there will be enough resources left for future generations.

**Enquiry** - a process or design used to gather information in the hope of gaining an answer of some sort.

1898

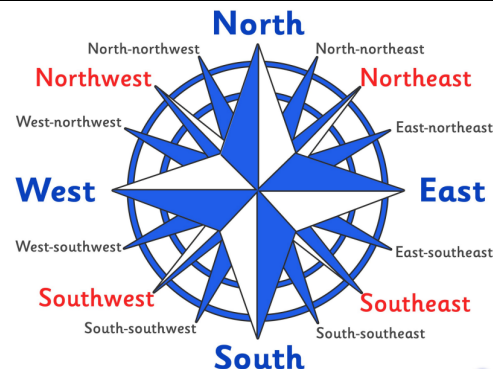

## Key Vocabulary

**Import** - brings (goods or services) into a country from abroad for sale

**Export** - sends (goods or services) to another country for sale

**Locally sourced** - goods that have been made or grown locally (nearby)

**Consumers** - a person who purchases goods and services for personal use

**Retailers** - a person or business that sells goods to the public in relatively small quantities for use or consumption rather than for resale

**Producers** - a person, company or country that makes, grows or supplies goods or commodities for sale

**Sustainable** - to develop a sustainable future you need to think about meeting today's needs and protecting the environments and resources for the future

**Trade** - the action of buying and selling goods and services

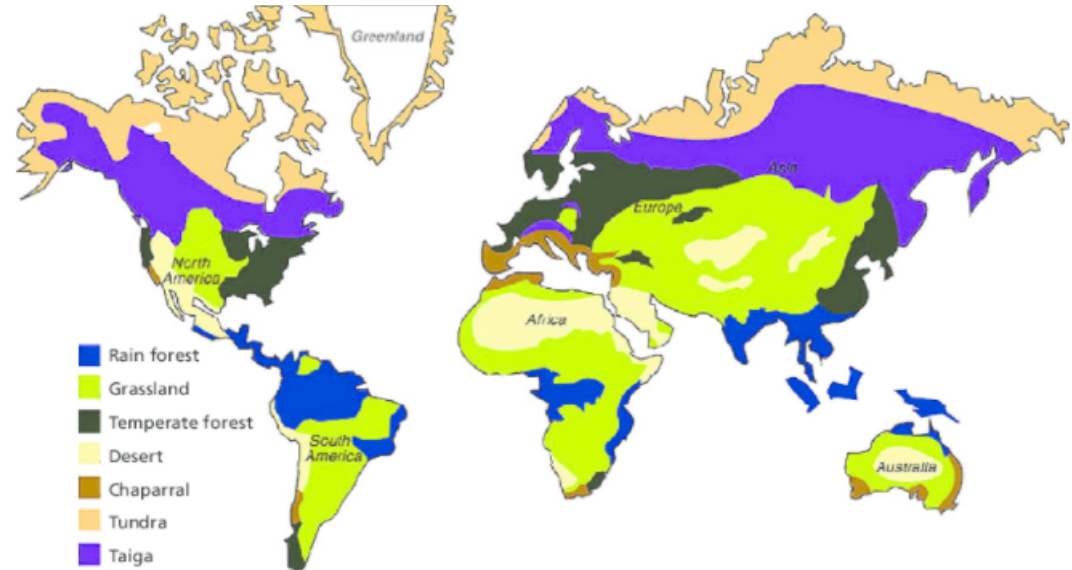
**Season** - a time of year marked by certain conditions: springs, summer, autumn, winter

**Biome** - geographical area defined by its climate, plant and animal life and the activities of the people who live there

**Climate** - weather patterns in place over a long period, such as seasonal rainfall, sunshine and temperatures

**Fairtrade** - trade between companies in developed countries and producers in developing countries in which fair prices are paid to the producers
