Lesson 2: To use modal verbs to explore an imaginary scenario.

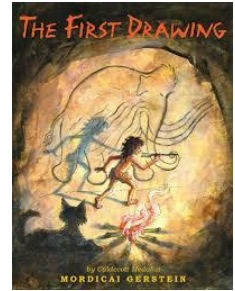
Lesson 3: To understand the features of a diary entry.

Lesson 2: To partition numbers up to 1000.

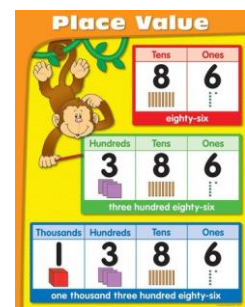
Lesson 3: To flexibly partition numbers to 1000.

Key Vocabulary: place value, ones, tens, hundreds, thousands, partition, digits.



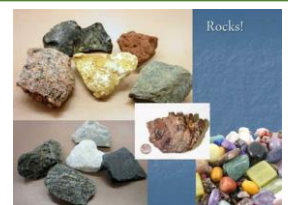
Science
