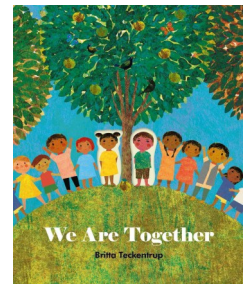

Year 3:

Science: To explain how a mirror works and describe how images in mirrors may look 'different'.

Geography: To demonstrate the relationship between maps and globes and how they relate to addresses

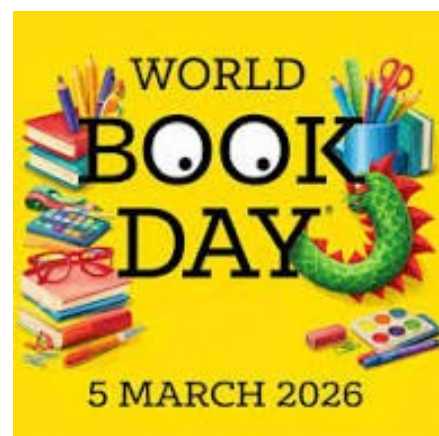
